On a yearly basis RVTTTC chooses a deserving recipient for three awards:

- *Canadian RVT of the Year,*
- *RVTTTC Recognition Award ‘Making a Difference’*
- *Sandy Hass Appreciation Award.*

*Each Provincial Association is to submit one nomination for each award.* Submissions, in WORD format, are to include the name and designation of the nominee, a brief biography of the nominee, and a summary of how and why this nominee meets the identified award criteria.

All nominations are reviewed and selected by the RVTTTC Board of Directors at the RVTTTC Annual General Meeting.

### **2018 Canadian RVT of the Year Award:**

*Awarded to a RVT who exemplifies the definition of an outstanding individual in the Veterinary Technology profession.*

*Award winners receive travel and accommodation arrangements (up to \$2500) and one CVMA Convention registration to attend the 2018 CVMA Convention in Vancouver, BC.*

Nominees must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a member in good standing with RVTTTC.
- Must have participated as a past or present Board Member of their association or **NEW** be a past or present award winner of a provincial RVT award as recognized by their own member organization.
- Be involved, active or current in the veterinary technology profession.
- Have outstanding performance in their workplace.

## **2017 RVTTC/TTVAC Recognition Award: ‘Making a Difference’:**

*Formally recognizes a RVT who has contributed to the RVT profession as part of their national association.*

Nominees must meet the following criteria:

- Be a previous RVTTC Board Member.
- Have shown exemplary performance and participation at their provincial level.
- Have shown exemplary performance and participation at their national level.
- Have extensive participation with projects and extended committee duties.
- Have contributed greatly to the profession of RVT.

## **2017 RVTTC/TTVAC Sandy Hass Appreciation Award:**

*Formally recognizes an individual or organization for their contribution to the Registered Veterinary Technologists and Technicians of Canada.*

Nominees must meet the following criteria:

- Have shown extended performance and participation.
- Have contributed greatly to the profession of RVT's in Canada.
